WHAT IS P3?

Panthers Protecting Panthers is a GU's sexual assault prevention education program funded by a federal grant through the Office on Violence Against Women. This grant provides funds to implement preventative education to students and employees surrounding domestic and dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking (DVDVSAS). Additionally, grant funds are being used improve response efforts to DVDVSAS crimes on campus.

WHAT DO WE DO?

The P3 program is headed by a Coordinated Community Response Team (CCRT) that is made up of many different departments across campus. This team works collaboratively to spearhead preventative education efforts and ensure a trauma informed response to reported sexual misconduct.

P3 recognizes that preventing and responding to sexual misconduct is a communal effort. That is why this program engages all students, departments, levels of administration, and community resources to work toward creating a safe campus environment.
